Having completed the parts about animals in danger and pollution, we will be preparing our work to show at a special assembly and also receiving the second part of the Earth Magic magician's award.</p>	<p><u>ICT: Computing</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will be continuing coding and moving on to Scratch programming using the basics we have learned in Hour of Code - designing our own game or animation. • We will be creating challenges in ordering using BeeBot and human robots! 	<p><u>History: The Vikings</u></p> <p>We will be continuing to learn about the Vikings: where they came from; how they invaded and settled; why they left Scandinavia; and how we know about them.</p> <p>We will study the Vikings in the context of early British history, using a timeline to place them between the Anglo Saxons and the Normans.</p>
