## ARRANGEMENTS FOR AUTUMN TERM

From September our new timings for **all** children will be **8.50 start and 3.05 finish**. Please can Y3 and Y4 parents line up with their children at the main door and R, Y1 and Y2 at the lower school door. Nursery will line up at the Nursery door as usual. At the end of the day children will leave from the same door with the exception of Year 4 who will leave from the fire exit door in their classroom (previously the Y1/2 classroom).

Please note, depending on the unpredictable situation with Covid we may have to revert to separate bubbles and staggered starts again at short notice.

We will maintain our standards of hygiene and continue with regular hand washing throughout the day. As mask wearing will no longer be mandatory we will leave this up to your discretion.

All children from Reception to Year 4 should have a PE kit in school from September. (shorts, top and PE shoes or trainers, but no football strips please). Year 1/2 will need wellies for Forest school for week 1 onwards and Year 3 and 4 will need a swimming kit from week 2. We will continue with swimming lessons at Alnwick for the Autumn term.
