Thank you for your patience whilst our building works completes. We are nearing the end of the project and anticipate returning to the Nursery classroom on Monday 19 September. Until then, Nursery and Reception children will continue to share the Reception classroom and we continue to have restricted access to school.

We still expect to have a crowded car park. We would prefer that you do not bring a car to school at the present time. However, if a car journey is unavoidable, please do not drop your child off in the middle of the car park. If the carpark is full, then please park outside the school grounds. We have seen a number of children this week walking across the car park unaccompanied and we do not want an accident to occur.

NURSERY CHILDREN

For this coming week, Mon 12 to Fri 16 Sept, please continue to use the outside gate for drop off and collection into the Early Years yard.

RECEPTION CHILDREN

For this coming week, Mon 12 to Fri 16 Sept, please continue to drop off your child in the Reception classroom in the morning. As your child will now stay in school for the afternoon, please come into school at 3pm to collect your child. If you have any older siblings in school, we will bring them to the Reception classroom at this time.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT/DAWN TO DUSK CHILDREN

School Transport/Dawn to Dusk children are brought into school by their transport provider at the start of the day. School Transport children are taken to their transport provider at the top of the carpark at the end of the day. Dawn to Dusk collect from school at the end of the day.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB CHILDREN

Taekwondo starts on Monday 12 Sept 3.15pm to 4.15pm. Trident Soccer starts on Thursday 15 Sept 3.15pm to 4.15pm. Children who have signed up for these clubs will be taken to them by a member of school staff.

If your Year 4 child returns a signed 'permission to walk home' slip, then they will be allowed to leave the school premises unaccompanied at the end of the day. All other children will be released from their lines in the yard.
