



Working parents with rural addresses could be eligible for 30 hours of free childcare for their 3 or 4 year old!

Applications will open on Friday 3rd February. There are a limited amount of places remaining for the term which begins 24th April 2017. Places will be offered on a first come first served basis linked to date and time of application. Applying and proving eligibility does not guarantee you will be able to access a place.

Checking eligibility is very easy; all you need to do is...

Ensure you meet the national economic eligibility criteria - families where both parents are working (or the sole parent is working in a lone-parent family) and each parent earns the equivalent of 16 hours a week at the national minimum or living wage and earns less than £100,000 a year. Ensure you meet the local rural address criteria - Visit www.northumberland.gov.uk and type your post code into **My Place** (top right hand side of the home page) and click the Schools and Education subheading.

You will be given access to submit an application and declaration form. This **MUST** be submitted by **Sunday 19th February 2017**.

What will happen next.....

You will be contacted via email by **Friday 3rd March 2017** with regards to the success of your application and if appropriate details of any evidence of your eligibility we may require.
