

Rothbury First School PE & Sports Premium Information

The Government provides £150 million per year directly to schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all children. The funding is ring-fenced and can only be spent on PE and sport provision in schools. Each school receives a lump sum of £8000 plus a premium of £5 per pupil.

In the Upper Coquet Valley, the schools have pooled their funding to work together as a Sports Partnership to help ensure that all pupils have access to high quality PE, appropriate sporting competition and opportunities to lead a healthy and active lifestyle.

2015-2016 PE & Sports Premium Expenditure

The school's allocation of funds for PE & Sports Premium is based upon our pupil census numbers.

We were allocated a total of **£8,400** in our 2015-2016 budget.

This was used as follows:

- Provision of a specialist PE teacher from Dr Thomlinson Middle School to deliver high quality PE to Rothbury pupils for half a day each week and support a PE programme with teachers in school.
- Participation in the Sports Partnership Programme for Upper Coquet Valley to coordinate a programme of events for all first school children in the Coquetdale Valley which:

Provided a calendar of appropriate competitive opportunities for pupils (for example: key stage festivals, intra and inter school competitions and visits to sporting/activity venues.)

Increased pupil's participation in level 2 and 3 School games competition

Increased the participation in a wider range of extra-curricular opportunities.

Developed pupil's leadership skills through sport.

- Contributed to the cost of transport to sporting events.
- Provision of a specialist Yoga teacher to teach Yogabugs for one term.
