



Rothbury First School PE & Sports Premium

The Government provides £150 million per year to schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all children. The funding is ring-fenced and can only be spent on PE and sport provision in schools. Rothbury First School has used this funding to ensure that all pupils have access to high quality PE, appropriate sporting competition and opportunities to lead a healthy and active lifestyle.

2020-21 Planned PE and Sports Premium Expenditure

Under the Primary PE and Sport funding initiative, in 2020/21 we will receive £16,882 to support PE and sport in our school. The impact of the funding must be considered in terms of these 5 key indicators

- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school
- The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
- Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- Increased participation in competitive sport

We propose to spend this money in the following ways;

£4000	Provision of a specialist PE teacher in school to deliver high quality PE lessons to our pupils for half a day a week.	Provision of specialist PE teaching has been accessed by all children across school. During lockdown periods, home learning suggestions were provided.
£2500	Improve the quality of children's physical education ensuring staff are competent and confident. CPD to enable staff to further sustain PE skills throughout school.	Staff have had access to specialist teaching activities and have gained knowledge and experience from this.
£1500	Provision of Playleader training to support play skills for children. The investment in Playleaders opportunities should help to provide stability to children when they most need it and equip them with strategies to cope at difficult times, thus enabling them to benefit from and	Unfortunately we were unable to invest in playleader opportunities. A paired down version of this was achieved in school, led by our KS2 staff and has been running effectively.

£310	Provision of playleader hoodies/vests to those in KS2	Playleader vests have been provided.
£1050	Provision of a specialist Yoga teacher to teach Yoga for three half terms.	Unfortunately we were unable to run yoga sessions due to being unable to have non essential visitors into school during restrictions.
£2000	Provision of specialised coaches: cricket, football, rugby etc.	Cricket coaching has taken place during this academic year. Trident soccer have provided football coaching to those children who have opted to do the after school activities.
£1052	Support for transport to swimming lessons.	Swimming lessons recommenced in the summer term of this academic year. Due to restrictions swimming was not able to take place in the Autumn and Spring terms.
£720	Support for children to attend sporting festivals, to include the cost of transport where applicable.	There have been opportunities for sporting festivals although these have not taken place due to cancellation.
£500	Support for bikeability lessons - provision of supervising adults.	Bikeability training took place in the summer term
£500	Provision of balance bike training for Reception and Year 1	Balance bike activities took place in the summer term.
£1500	Provision of training for teachers.	Staff have had access to specialist teaching activities and have gained knowledge and experience from this.
£600	Support for after-school clubs - provision of facilities	Ballet/Dance/Trident clubs continued after lockdown
£50	Support for summer soccer camp - provision of facilities	No summer soccer camp due to COVID restrictions

£550	Support for Forest School - outdoor First Aid certificate	Forest School teacher - training renewed
£550	Support for PE - Paediatric First Aid certificate	Training renewed for 3 members of staff
